


PROPORTION OF ADULTS WHO EXPERIENCED IPV

AT SOME POINT DURING THEIR LIFETIME, BY SEX




PROPORTION OF ADULTS WHO EXPERIENCED SEXUAL

sexual violence at some point




PROPORTION OF ADULTS WHO EXPERIENCED SEXUAL ASSAULT
