
# What crime is reported to the police?


Only 23% of crimes were reported to the Police over the last 12 months. Household offences were reported more often (34%) than personal offences (17%).

## PROPORTION OF CRIME REPORTED BY VICTIMS' SEX



**Male and female victims** report to the Police almost equally often.

#### PROPORTION OF CRIME REPORTED BY OFFENCE TYPES



**KEY 1** | BUBBLE SIZE REFLECTS THE **PREVALENCE RATE** OF EACH TYPE OF OFFENCE **KEY 2** | BUBBLE SHADING REFLECTS THE **PROPORTION** AN OFFENCE TYPE WAS REPORTED TO THE POLICE

**Theft of motor vehicles** is the offence most commonly reported to the police over the last 12 months **(82%). Fraud/deception and cybercrime** are the offences least commonly reported to the Police **(7%).** 


## PROPORTION OF CRIME REPORTED BY VICTIMS' PERCEPTION



If people perceive that the incident is a crime, they are more likely to report it to the police.

**NOTE:** Bubble size reflects the proportion of all incidents viewed as a crime **(59%)** or not a crime **(34%).** 

### PROPORTION OF CRIME REPORTED BY VICTIMS' PERCEPTION OF SERIOUSNESS



Generally, if people **perceive that the incident is serious,** they are more likely to report it to the Police.
