Direction

- 1. Section 136(5) of the Act provides that a person authorised by a temporary authority to carry on the sale and supply of alcohol in premises for which an onlicence or off-licence is in force has the same duties, obligations and liabilities as the holder of the on-licence or off-licence concerned.
- Every application for a temporary authority should be referred to the police and a licensing inspector for comment and report. The Authority considers that each DLC should determine their own procedures for the provision of such reports when urgent comment is required.
- 3. For the avoidance of doubt every applicant for a temporary authority should be provided with a copy of any report or comment provided to the DLC prior to any decision being made on the application.
